<p>The meeting was called to order at 7:02 pm by chair Susan Ludwig. The minutes of the September, 2009 meeting were approved. The statistical report for September, 2009 was approved.</p> <p>The proposed changes to the Library Card Policy were distributed. The word <i>patrons</i> will be changed to <i>cardholders</i> in a number of locations. There were some minor wordsmithing changes. The final proposed policy will be distributed for a decision at the November meeting.</p> <p>Library staff are looking at responses to the H1N1 flu. Sanitizers have been placed on counters around the library. Susan reminded library staff that alcohol based sanitizers aren't allowed in child care centers for safety reasons. Library staff will make sure the ones in children's remain behind the counter and the others are on higher counters where parents would make the decision whether to use on their child or not. It was suggested that we put step stools in the restrooms to make it easier for children to wash their hands.</p> <p>The Board discussed the Making Room to Read Campaign Cabinet. We are still waiting to hear from the Rotary Foundation on our request of \$40,000. The cabinet is looking at ways to reinvigorate itself with new members and purpose.</p> <p>The work plan for September was reviewed. The new city/ library web site went live the first of September and is working well for the library.</p> <p>The next meeting is November 19, 2009.
