<p>The meeting was called to order at 7:03 pm by chair Susan Ludwig. The minutes of the October, 2009 meeting were approved. The statistical report for October, 2009 was approved.</p> <p>The proposed changes to the Library Card Policy were distributed. It was moved and seconded to approve the policy. The vote was unanimous.</p> <p>Library staff have been surviving the H1N1 flu situation. We've had one or two staff with family members with the H1N1, but no actual staff have come down with it. We've had our share of colds, however. Sanitizers have been placed on counters around the library.</p> <p>The Board discussed the Making Room to Read Campaign Cabinet. The group will makes some changes in 2010 to reinvigorate itself.</p> <p>The work plan for October was reviewed. There are plans for a Farmers Market near the library's Carnegie Court this summer which should be a nice asset to the library. The Holiday Tree lighting will be December 3rd and it is the 25th anniversary lighting. The web site continues to be heavily used and the Library pages are visited more than any other city department. The City Council gave approval for the library to be closed on March 26, 2010 for all staff to attend the national Public Library Association conference in Portland.
