One of the new features we’re excited to highlight is the [ReciteMe toolbar](#), accessed using the dark blue button with an icon of a person on it. ReciteMe includes features like contrast and font style modifications, a built-in screen reader, and an incredible translation feature to make sure our website can be understood in nearly every language.

In the last three years, the city has made strides to improve customer service, and this new website marks the end of this era of reform. We’re excited to move forward into a future of improvement, continually working to make our city “A Great Place to Grow”.
