Construction Excise Tax Exemption Form

The Oregon Legislature passed a law (SB 1036) that provides a financial tool to help local school districts pay for a portion of the cost for new or expanded facilities needed due to growth in the community.

The tax is required to be paid by the developer or property owner developing the property in the Newberg School District at the time when the developer or owner requests a permit issued by the County.

If an exemption is approved and it is later determined that the project does not qualify for a tax exemption, the permit holder will be held liable for paying the tax as well as all legal and collections costs associated with collecting the tax.

If you are exempt for one of the following please complete the form below. Please check the exemption(s) that qualify you:

- Private school improvements;
Public improvements as defined in ORS 279A.010;
Residential housing that is guaranteed to be affordable...
Public or private hospital improvements;
Improvements to religious facilities primarily used for worship or education associated with worship;
Agricultural buildings, as defined in ORS 455.315 (2) (a).
