

RECOMMENDATION:

Consider a motion to appoint the most qualified candidate to fill the City Council District No. 6 vacant position created by the resignation of Mr. Bob Larson for a term expiring December 31, 2010.

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

On April 12, 2010, Councilor Bob Larson submitted his letter of resignation, creating a vacancy on the City Council for the District No. 6 position with a term expiring December 31, 2010.

On April 19, 2010, City Council adopted **Resolution No. 2010-2895** accepting the resignation, declaring the position vacant, and directing staff to advertise for qualified persons for appointment to fill the vacancy.

On April 29, 2010, a letter was drafted by Mayor Bob Andrews and sent to residents within the boundaries of District No. 6. Thirteen applications meeting all the requirements were received to be considered as candidates. Council reviewed the applications and narrowed the candidate pool down to five individuals to be interviewed during a special meeting of the Newberg City Council on June 28, 2010, and considered for appointment.





 - Give direction to the City Attorney concerning on-going litigation, claims and other legal matters.
 - Annually evaluate the City Manager, City Attorney, and Municipal Judges.
 - Various other responsibilities of running a municipal corporation.

- **District #6 General Boundaries:** District #6 is bound on the North by the railroad (Crestview Drive), Douglas Avenue, and Vittoria Way; on the South by Wyooski Road and city limits; on the West by Villa Road, Elliott Road, Hwy 219, and city limits; and on the East by Eagle Street and city limits. Precise boundaries will need to be checked with the City Recorder.

- **Deadline:** A completed application must be received at City Hall by 5:00 p.m. on Friday, May 21, 2010. Applications may be obtained at Newberg City Hall from Norma Alley or by calling (503) 537-1283. **The City Council reserves the right to extend the deadline if the Council feels it is advisable or would be in the best interest of the city.**

- **Appointment Date:** The Council may make the appointment at its regular meeting of Monday, June 21, 2010, beginning at 7:00 p.m. Applicants are required to attend in order to be considered for the position. If someone is appointed, they will take office on July 6, 2010. The Council may delay appointment at their discretion.

26 with a cover letter explaining that I did not receive the mailed notice.

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
