

# WM in Yamhill County

## WM is an Economic Asset to Yamhill County



- 48 family-wage jobs
- \$1 million every year to the County from Riverbend
- \$120,000 property taxes
- \$10 million investment at Riverbend in 2009 - renewable energy plant
- \$16+ million investment at Riverbend since 2013
- \$1.2 million investment in Newberg Transfer Station

# Services for the City of Newberg

## Residential Services - 5,627 Customers

- Garbage - weekly various sizes (volume based rates)
- Recycling - every-other-week collection, roll cart provided by WM
- Yard Debris - every-other-week collection, roll cart provided by WM

## Commercial Services - 458 Customers

Collection Frequency to meet the customers need for Garbage and Recycling with containers provided by Waste Management

## Industrial Services

Drop Box services for industrial customers and temporary boxes for construction and residential projects


