-Items brought to the event must be placed in the trunk or truck bed of the vehicle. Items are not to be placed in plastic bags nor in containers that you wish to keep.

-You must remain in your vehicle while in line. These events can have long wait times, so please plan accordingly.



## **Accepted Items:**



-Pesticides, herbicides, fungicides
-Anti-freeze, greases, auto fluids
-CLF bulbs and Fluorescent light tubes
-Batteries: household, lead-acid, etc.
-Old gasoline and diesel
-Paint not accepted at Paintcare Locations
www.paintcare.org (no empty paint cans)
-Aerosol cans (no empty ones)
-Items labeled: dangerous, poisonous,
flammable, hazardous, reactive, corrosive

These events are open to residential households of Yamhill County. No business waste will be accepted.

Individual containers cannot be larger than 5 gallons each



## **Items Not Accepted:**



Medications (over the counter, prescription, animal):
Your local police department and/or city hall have
drop boxes open year-round for disposal.

Sharps/Syringes (this is medical waste): Sharps boxes can be purchased and disposed of at:

Waste Management- Wynooski St, Newberg @ the transfer station booth; Recology- call for drop off/pick up from residence (503) 472-3176

**Used Motor Oil (not mixed):** Used motor oil can be recycled year-round at Waste Management Newberg and Recology Recovery Zone.

Propane tanks/green camping cylinders: McMinnville
Gas in McMinnville will recycle these items for a
minimal fee (free for the green camping ones!)

**Explosives/ammunition:** Contact your local police department for disposal.
