**RE: Notice of Construction
2022 Pavement Improvements Project**

Project Background

City of Newberg Municipal Code Section 3.45.060 provides authorization for the collection of a transportation utility fee (TUF) for the preservation and rehabilitation of the citywide pavement system. Pavement preservation projects include a complete reconstruction of aggregate base with new pavement and sidewalk ramp improvements to meet ADA standard.

Two city streets are selected for this fiscal year: (a) N Brutscher Street, from E Hayes St to Hwy 99W, and (b) E Sherman Street, from N School St to N Meridian St.

Eagle-Elsner, Inc. authorized for this project by Council Resolution No. 2022-3824.



CONSTRUCTION:

Eagle-Elsner, Inc. will begin **ADA sidewalk ramp reconstruction on October 24, 2022.** Ramp reconstruction will focus first on **N Brutscher Street between Highway 99W and E Hayes Street.** Ramp reconstruction on **E Sherman Street between N School Street and N Meridian Street** will follow after that. Construction requires a favorable weather condition for concrete work. Ramp reconstruction may continue into next year until they are all complete. Full depth pavement reclamation work will begin when spring weather returns in 2023. A separate notification for pavement work will be provided at that time. (Note: Traffic detour will be implemented for pavement work.)

The Contractor will put in place a traffic plan to shift traffic lanes for safety in construction zone. Streets will remain open for traffic. Pedestrians will be provided with a temporary path. Please observe traffic control and expect traffic delay. Emergency vehicle and traffic access will be allowed. Work hours are 7:00 am to 6:00 pm Monday through Friday each week except for holidays.

WHAT YOU CAN DO:

- Expect traffic delays due to ADA sidewalk ramp construction.
- Observe traffic control signs, watch for workers in the area, and drive with care for everyone’s safety.
