**THE POSITION**

Performs a variety of unskilled or semi-skilled maintenance work and operates a variety of equipment in the construction, operation, repair, maintenance, and replacement of City water, wastewater, street maintenance, storm drainage, grounds, buildings, facilities, and other utility systems.

**SPECIAL REQUIREMENTS**

- Valid state driver's license; Class A CDL required within sixty (60) days of appointment.
- Training and certification to be completed within one hundred-eighty (180) days of appointment:
  - ✓ Public Agency Work Zone Traffic Control Class and Flagger Certification.
  - ✓ Cave-in Protection/Competent Person training.
  - ✓ CPR/First Aid and AED Certification.

In addition, at least one of the following Certificates/Licenses may be required to be eligible for Step 8 or higher on the salary schedule as determined by the Public Works Maintenance Superintendent:

- Public Pesticide Applicators License, including Right of Way, Ornamental and Turf Herbicide, or Regulatory Weed Control,
- Certification as Water Distribution System Operator I or higher.
- Wastewater Collection Systems Operator I or higher.

**MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS**

Education and Experience:

- Graduation from high school or GED equivalent.

**SELECTION PROCESS**

**Application forms are required** and must be received at Human Resources Department **no later than 4:30 pm on July 8, 2016**. Formal application rating on education, training and experience; oral interview, reference check and job related tests will be required. A successful drug screen, criminal background check and pre-employment "Physical Capacity" exam will be required as a condition of new employment. **Applications** are available from:
