The Newberg Library Friends are happy to receive your books and other donations in good condition.

We are unable to accept materials in these conditions:

- Mold & Mildew, either visibly or with an odor. (Mold & Mildew are toxic. We can't have them in the library as it can transfer to other books.) Please just toss them.
- Strong odors (cigarette smoke, etc.)
- Water damage or stains, ripped or torn pages/covers
- Boxes/containers that are dirty (i.e. sitting in a garage for months or years.)
- Books with hi-lighting/margin notes
- Weekly news magazines (other recent magazines in good condition are accepted)
- Encyclopedias/textbooks over 3 years old
- CDS or DVD that are homemade copies
