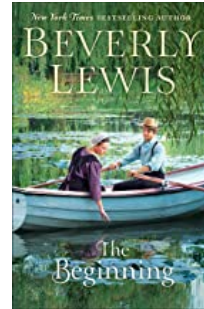

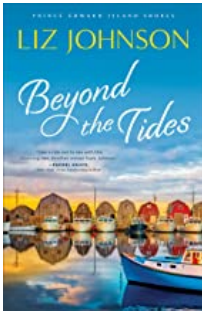

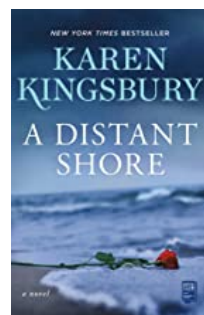
To Lena, her faith has always been her compass, but can she remain steadfast when the questions grow increasingly complex and the answers could mean the difference between life and death?

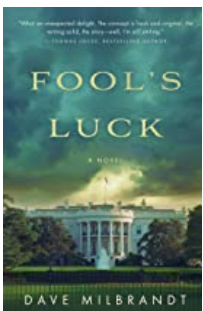

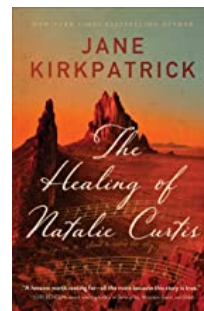

by Dave Milbrandt

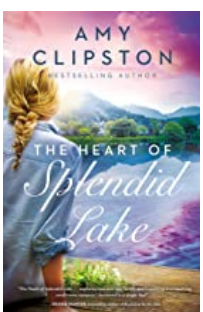
Teacher Myles Bradford wins the lottery, and decides to do something truly unexpected: run for President of the United States. Bradford may learn that even success has its price.

by Amy Clipston

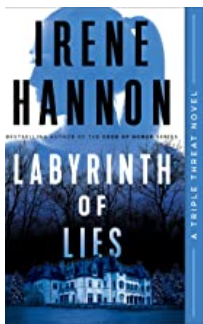

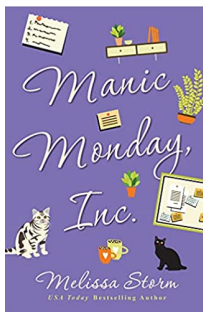

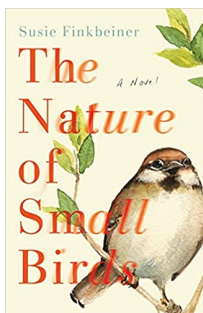

by Lauraine Snelling

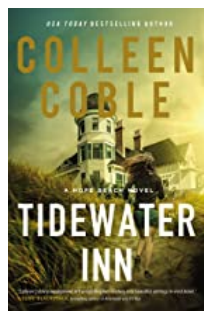

by Betsy St. Amant

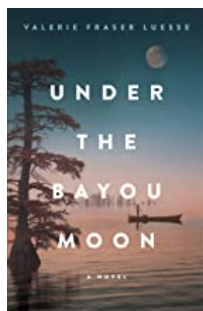
