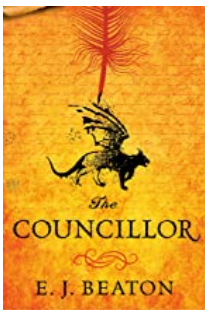

by Veronica Schanoes

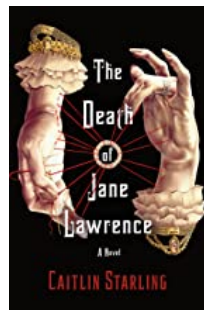

by E.J. Beaton

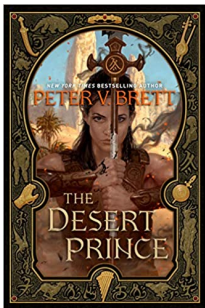

by Peter V. Brett

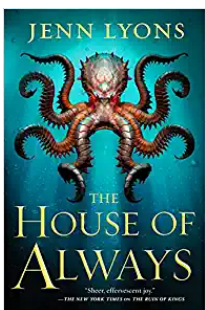

by Jenn Lyons

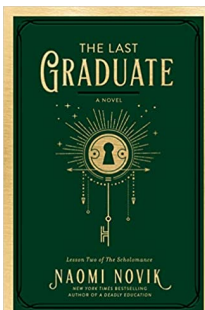

by Zoraida Córdova

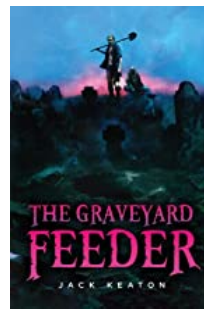

by Jack Keaton

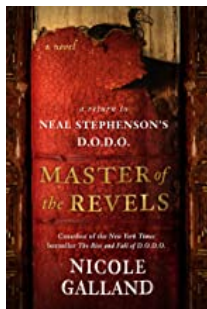
Groundskeeper Burke Sawyer is in a rush to save his deceased father's soul from a menacing creature buried underground who is feeding on the corpses in the cemetery.

by Karen Marie Moning

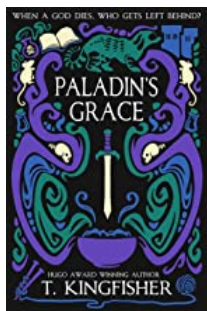

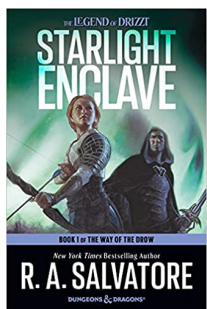

by C. L. Clark

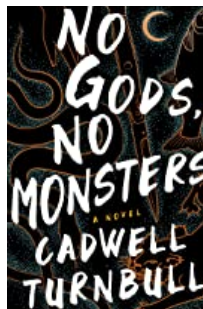

by Cadwell Turnbull

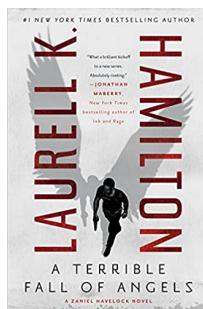

by Alix. E. Harrow

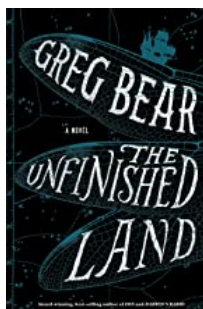
