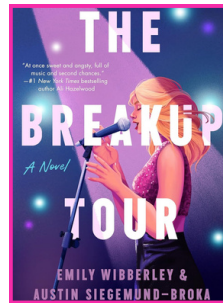

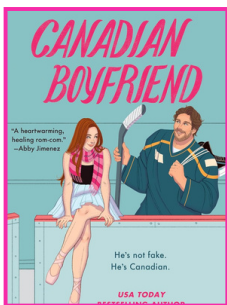

by Jenny Holiday

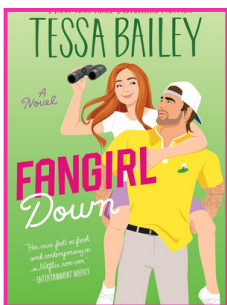
