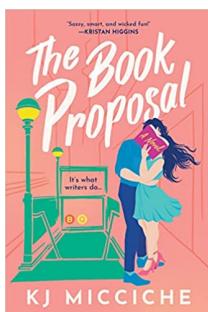


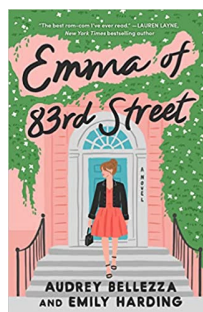

by Audrey Bellezza & Emily Harding

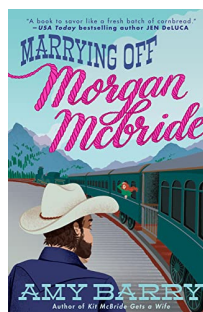

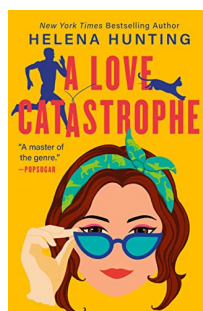


Unfortunately Yours
