Payment of a \$150 non-refundable application fee and a \$1,500 refundable meter and valve deposit are due at the time of application.					
The application fee covers account set up and the first 1,337 Cubic Feet (10,000 gallons) of water used within the first month. In					
addition, the applicant will pay a monthly billing fee of \$10; a daily rental fee of \$5 as well as a monthly Stormwater Service Charge					
at the current rate. Water used in excess of the first 10,000 gallons will be charged at the current industrial volume rate. Failure to					
reimburse the city for usage on a monthly basis is considered a violation of city code 13.15.040 which will result in immediate					
termination of nydrant meter t	usage and/or a fine of \$500.00 or	more.			
USE & LOCATION OF ME	ETER:				
City water shall only be provided through a hydrant meter. Violation of this provision, City Code Section 13.15.050, will result in a					
Class 2 civil infraction, which carries a fine of \$500.00 or more. It is your responsibility to notify the City when you have moved the					
hydrant meter to a new location for monthly readings and inspections. Failure to do so may result in forfeiture of the hydrant meter and					
indefinite suspension of hydrant water use privileges. In the event of an emergency the City may discontinue water use at any time					
pursuant to City Code 13.15.2	40.				
LIABILITIES:					
The applicant assumes FULL RESPONSIBILITY for any and all damage to the hydrant meter, hydrant and/or the City of Newberg's					
water distribution system caused by the abuse, vandalism, neglect, or misuse of the hydrant meter. Costs associated with damage will					
be billed to the applicant by the City and could result in the denial of future use of a hydrant meter. The applicant should remove and					
secure the hydrant meter nightly for protection. DO NOT use the hydrant valve as your flow control valve. Turn the hydrant valve					
on completely and use the gate	valve on the hydrant meter to cor	ntrol your water flow.	The applicant furth	her agrees to provide an approved	
backflow prevention device to	protect the water distribution sy	stem.
