

Dear Resident,

Welcome to the 2010 run of the Newberg Old Fashioned Festival. Since your home is in or near the center of the four days of activities, you should be aware of some extra traffic control measures during the days of the Festival and an additional change in the traffic grid around Memorial Park.

First, the Newberg Public Works, Fire, and Police Departments are working together to provide a more pedestrian safe environment for the hundreds of people in the park. Through the weekend, the Fire Department will be blocking off the two residential streets on the east and south sides of the park to promote pedestrian safety as Festival attendees gather in the park. As activities slow during portions of the weekend, the streets will be opened.

The barricades will be placed on the south side of E. Fourth/S. Howard and extend to E. Sixth Street. Additionally, E. Fifth Street may be blocked from S. Howard to S. Blaine Streets.

Traffic grid is establishing one-way southbound on S. Howard between E. Third and E. Fourth, and eastbound on E. Fourth to S. School. Additional disabled parking will be available along these streets.

We hope Festival attendees' safety will be enhanced in this temporary blocking of the streets. At times, some residents will have difficulty getting in and out of their homes. The Fire Department will be visiting you with a parking pass or permit to drive into the area during the hours of barricaded streets.

Second, the Old Fashioned Festival Car Show will run all day Sunday, July 25. The display area will again be primarily on E. Sixth from S. Blaine to S. Edwards, and along the 500 block S. Howard. We expect up to 150-200 entries. The cars will be diagonally parked along those streets. We are asking residents along the streets to avoid driving through the displays for safety reasons, but we will work to accommodate residents to get in and out of their homes during Sunday's show.

Finally, Tuesday, July 20, crews from Public Works will be emphasizing street cleaning for the parade day. We are asking you to remove all vehicles from the parade route and the streets bordering Memorial Park to allow the sweepers and other crews to finish cleaning the streets and curbs. Their work will continue all day Tuesday. Your cooperation is appreciated.

Thank you for cooperating with the Old Fashioned Festival Committee and the City in helping make this annual event a success. We greatly appreciate your flexibility and patience in making these changes in your lifestyle. 
