

## RESOLUTION No. 2014-3154

**A RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE AMENDMENT TO THE COLLECTIVE BARGAINING AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY AND THE NEWBERG-DUNDEE PUBLIC SAFETY, AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXTEND THE CURRENT CONTRACT 90-DAYS, THROUGH SEPTEMBER 30, 2014, AS WELL AS DELEGATING THE AUTHORITY TO MAKE SUCH AMENDMENT ON BEHALF OF THE CITY**

### RECITALS:


1. The current Collective Bargaining Agreement was effective July 1, 2011, and expires June 30, 2014.
2. City staff has been in discussions with The Newberg-Dundee Public Safety Association, (the "Association") representatives concerning language changes, modifications and compensation for the new contract period July 1, 2014, through June 30, 2017, tentatively.
3. Thus far, Tentative Agreements have been made regarding contract language changes and modifications in several of the contract articles to include non-compensatory and compensatory items.
4. Discussions and agreements regarding specific compensation amounts have been discussed briefly, but the City and Association are not yet close to an agreement regarding final compensation numbers.

### THE CITY OF NEWBERG RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:


1. The City approves the Amendment of the 90-day extension to the current Collective Bargaining Agreement to now expire September 30, 2014.
2. On June 11, 2014, the Association ratified the contract extension to September 30, 2014.
3. The city manager is authorized to execute the Amendment to the Agreement with the Association on behalf of the City and to interpret the Agreement.
4. The city attorney will review and approve the Agreement as to legal sufficiency.

➤ **EFFECTIVE DATE** of this resolution is the day after the adoption date, which is: June 17, 2014.
