A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER PRO TEM TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH SCHNEIDER EQUIPMENT, INC. WATER SERVICES FOR THE UPSIZING OF WELL NO. 8 IN THE AMOUNT OF \$70,600.00

RECITALS:


1. The City of Newberg relies on groundwater supply from the City's well field to meet its water supply demands. Within the last 18 months, wells No. 1 and 2, which produce approximately 600 gallons per minute (gal/min) have failed and have been decommissioned.
2. In order to replace the capacity lost with the failure of these two wells, The City's design consultant, CH2MHill, designed and solicited quotes for the upsizing the pump and motor of well No. 8, which will increase its capacity by 700 gal/min.
3. The City, with the help of its consultant, solicited quotes for the improvements and received three quotes. The quotes were:
 - Schneider Equipment, Inc. Water Services \$70,600.00
 - Triangle Pump and Equipment \$80,721.00
 - HPS Construction Inc \$81,734.10
4. The lowest quote received was Schneider Equipment, Inc Water services for \$70,600.00

THE CITY OF NEWBERG RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:


The city council, acting as Contract Review Board for the city, authorizes the city manager pro tem to enter into a contract with Schneider Equipment, Inc. Water Services for an amount of \$70,600.00 for the upsizing of Well No. 8.
