

RESOLUTION No. 2013-3033

**A RESOLUTION TO PURCHASE A REPLACEMENT VACTOR 2100 FROM
OWEN EQUIPMENT COMPANY IN THE AMOUNT OF \$359,176.00**

RECITALS:


1. The City of Newberg operates its Vactor to clean and maintain over 75 miles of wastewater lines and 32 miles of storm lines and culverts within Newberg city limits.
2. The 1994 Vactor is reaching the end of its serviceable life. Over the years, improvements have been made to combination sewer cleaners (Vactors) that increase efficiency and improve operator safety. Replacement of the Vactor will allow staff to realize these improvements and continue to meet the maintenance needs of the City for the next fifteen years.
3. The City entered into an Interagency Cooperative Purchasing Agreement with National Joint Powers Alliance (NJPA), effective March 20, 2012. The NJPA agreement complies with Oregon Revised Statute (ORS) 279A, Public Contracts and Purchasing and the Newberg Municipal Code Chapter 3.25, Purchasing and Contracting.
4. The NJPA developed specifications and solicited bids. Vactor Manufacturing, Inc was awarded the purchase contract for the Vactor 2100.
5. The City selects Owen Equipment Company, the authorized dealer for Vactor Manufacturing Inc., to provide a new Vactor 2100 on a Freightliner chassis at a cost of \$359,176.00.

THE CITY OF NEWBERG RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

1. The City Council acting as the Contract Review Board authorizes the city manager to enter into all contracts and agreements for the purchase of a replacement Vactor 2100 from Owen Equipment Company. The city attorney will approve all contracts and agreements as to form and content.
2. The City will purchase the Vactor outright by transferring the originally budgeted lease cost of \$350,000.00 from line item 32-5110.610500 to line item 32-5110.610002 to accurately reflect the purchase versus lease of a replacement Vactor. This movement between line items is consistent with and according to local budget law and the appropriation authority chosen by City Council.


➤ **EFFECTIVE DATE** of this resolution is the day after the adoption date, which is: February 5, 2013.
