
A RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE THE CITY MANAGER PRO TEM TO ENTER INTO A CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT WITH K&E EXCAVATING, INC. FOR THE PAVEMENT REHABILITATION, WASTEWATER PIPELINE REPLACEMENT AND THE CITY OWNED PARKING LOT ON SECOND STREET MAINTENANCE PROJECT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$942,915.00.

RECITALS:

1. The City of Newberg advertised the Pavement Rehabilitation, Wastewater Pipeline Replacement and the City owned Parking Lot on Second Street Maintenance Project in the Daily Journal of Commerce and received one qualified bid from K & E Excavating, Inc. on July 8, 2015.
2. Upon review of the submitted bid, staff has determined that the proposed unit pricing is reasonable, but due to budgetary constraints, pavement work in Elliott Road from Hayes Street to E. 2nd Street will be excluded from this construction project.
3. This bid award consists of the following items and totals \$942,915.00. This project provides:
 - (a) Pavement rehabilitation for Meridian Street (from E. 1st Street to E. 2nd Street), S. Main Street (from E. 1st Street to E. 3rd Street) and N. Main Street (from Nugget Lane to Melody Court) for \$219,846.00, funded through account number 18-5150-702171; and
 - (b) Wastewater pipeline replacement on Meridian Street (from E. 1st Street to E. 4th Street) for \$446,364.00, funded through account number 04-5150-706301; and
 - (c) Maintenance and improvements of the City owned Parking Lot on Second Street that includes stormwater and wastewater pipeline replacement for \$276,705.00, funded by street funds through account number 18-5150-702174, wastewater funds through account number 04-5150-706404, and stormwater funds through account number 04-5150-717711.
4. Construction for the project will begin in August and is anticipated to be fully complete by November, 2015.


THE CITY OF NEWBERG RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

1. The City Council, acting as the contract review board for the city, does hereby authorize the City Manager Pro Tem to enter into a construction contract with K & E Excavating, Inc. to complete the city's Pavement Rehabilitation, Wastewater Pipeline Replacement and the City owned Parking Lot on Second Street Maintenance Project in the amount of \$942,915.00.

2. The City Manager Pro Tem is authorized to negotiate and approve any needed construction change orders not to exceed 10 percent of the original contract amount.


