Dear applicant:

Your application materials for a proposed outdoor play structure at Joan Austin Elementary School were received on December 27, 2022 and reviewed for completeness. The Type II site design review application materials are **deemed complete**.

Please provide three hard copies of all application materials for use in agency referral and design review. Once we receive the additional hard copies of all application materials, the application will be routed for the 15-day agency review and referral period, after which a decision will be issued.

Type II project review also requires public noticing and a public comment period pursuant to adopted procedures in the Newberg Municipal Code. Attached you will find a marked-up version of your neighborhood mailer and sign posting. Please add the missing information to the mailer (in bold) and submit a final copy to me prior to preparing your mailing.

Based on City requirements and the length of lot frontage for the subject property, one noticing sign is required along N Center Street. The noticing sign must be waterproof, measuring a minimum of two feet by three feet, and if possible, the notice shall be posted within 10 feet of a street lot line and be visible to pedestrians and motorists. Notices shall not be posted in a public right-of-way or on trees.
