

**NOTICE OF URBAN GROWTH BOUNDARY AMENDMENT ADOPTION
(Amended)**

On May 20, 2013, the City of Newberg made its final decision regarding adoption of an amendment to its Urban Growth Boundary (UGB). This amendment includes 132 gross buildable acres (260 total acres) into the UGB to accommodate identified industrial land needs. The area is on the south side of Newberg south of Wyooski Road, on the east side of Adolf Road south of Wilsonville Road, and along both sides of Highway 219 just south of Wyooski Road. The amendment also includes redesignation of some land already in the Newberg UGB to industrial, and adopts an update to the Newberg Economic Opportunities Analysis, Newberg Comprehensive Plan, and Newberg Transportation System Plan. On July 18, 2013, the Yamhill County Commissioners also adopted the Urban Growth Boundary amendment.

If you believe the city did not satisfactorily complete the UGB amendment or that the amendment does not comply with the statewide planning goals, you may object to the Oregon Department of Land Conservation and Development (DLCD). To file an objection with DLCD, you must do three things. First, address these requirements in your objection:

1. Show how you participated in the UGB amendment either by speaking at a public meeting or by sending written comments about the proposal;
2. Explain your objection to the adopted amendment. Be as specific as possible, including what goal, rule, or statute you believe has been violated and why; and
3. Recommend a specific change that would resolve your objection.

Second, submit the written objection to:

DLCD must receive the objection by Monday, September 16, 2013.
