



RESOLUTION No. 2019-3572

A RESOLUTION EXTENDING THE STREET SEAT PILOT PROGRAM FOR TWO YEARS THROUGH AUGUST 17, 2021

RECITALS:


1. On August 17, 2015 the City Council adopted Resolution No. 2015-3209 and created a Street Seat Pilot Program with a two year duration.
2. On July 17, 2017 the City Council adopted Resolution No. 2017-3397 extending the Street Seat Pilot program for two years.
3. The pilot program will expire on August 17, 2019 if it is not extended or turned into a permanent program.
4. The City Council finds that the Street Seat Pilot Program has been successful in adding vitality to downtown, and that the program should be continued to allow the creation of additional street seats and to allow staff to refine the draft standards for street seats.

THE CITY OF NEWBERG RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:


1. The City Council approves extending the Street Seat Pilot Program two years. The expiration date will extend from August 17, 2019 to August 17, 2021.
