### A RESOLUTION EXTENDING THE STREET SEAT PILOT PROGRAM FOR TWO YEARS THROUGH AUGUST 17, 2023

#### RECITALS:


1. On August 17, 2015, the City Council adopted Resolution No. 2015-3209 and created a Street Seat Pilot Program with a two-year duration.
2. On July 17, 2017, the City Council adopted Resolution No. 2017-3397 extending the Street Seat Pilot program for two years.
3. The pilot program expired on August 17, 2021, due to staffing challenges to get an extension of the program before the City Council.
5. The City Council finds that the Street Seat Pilot Program has been successful in adding vitality to downtown, addresses the COVID-19 pandemic to allow outdoor dining opportunities for restaurants, and that the program should be continued to allow the creation of additional street seats, and to allow staff to refine the draft standards for street seats if necessary.

#### THE CITY OF NEWBERG RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:


1. The City Council approves extending the Street Seat Pilot Program two years. The expiration date will extend from August 17, 2021, to August 17, 2023.
