NOTICE OF PLANNING COMMISSION HEARING ***Proposed Changes to Temporary and Portable Sign Usage***

The Newberg Planning Commission will hold a public hearing on November 13, 2014 at 7 p.m. at the Newberg Public Safety Building, 401 E. Third Street, Newberg, OR, to evaluate the following proposal:

An update to the Newberg Development Code language regarding the usage of temporary and portable signs. The proposal:

- Adds a new section for a temporary sign permit program that will allow additional temporary and portable sign usage with a coordinated appearance in the C-2, C3, and Institutional zones.
- Adds new language to address the use of pennants, streamers, and inflatable objects.
- Adds new language to clarify the definition of a flag display and flag use on holidays.

We invite you to participate in the Planning Commission's review of this proposal by speaking at the hearing, or by sending in written comments. Oral testimony is normally limited to five minutes per speaker. You may submit written comments to the Newberg Planning Division at 414 E. First Street, or by mail.
