

Overgrowth is Hazardous!

Sidewalks and streets with overgrown vegetation can:

- Force pedestrians to walk in the street
- Present physical hazards to pedestrians and vehicles
- Block visibility at intersections
- · Force taller vehicles to drive down the center of the road
